Human activities are transforming natural Human activities are transforming natural environments by moving species beyond the limits of their native geographic ranges into areas in with they do not naturally occur. Many of these alien species have become invastve, causing substartial changes to ecosystems and leading to native species extractions. Invasive Allen Species (IAS) have become one of the major threats to biodiversity across the world.

It is important to recognise harmful invasive also important to recognise training measure alien species at an early stage of introduction in order to miligate negative impacts. There is therefore a critical need for the capacity to evaluate, compare, and predict the magnitudes of the impacts of different alien species, in order to determine and prioritise appropriate actions where necessary

The IUCN Species Survival Commission Invasive Species Specialist Group (ISSG) have developed a tool to support this prioritisation process.

**Environmental Impact Classification of Alien** Taxa (EICAT)

EICAT is an assessment process that classifies alien species into one of five categories, according to the magnitude of the detrimental impacts to the environment.




