

# **Understanding social change in the local population with municipal income. The case of the Region of Murcia, Spain**

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*The aim of this paper is to analyze the reality of socioeconomic change in the local population of an area with municipal income and its estimation. As official statistics of income in Spain at the municipal level do not exist, we provide reliable statistical information on the gross disposable income of households per capita (GDIHpc), by estimating a spatial model in the local geographical area. Information on the economic and social situation of different territories is necessary in order to plan balanced development in each.*
